Learning

Religion–We will be setting aside out normal eligion textbook and will be focusing on a religion text that is specifically focusing on the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Look for the book to be coming home to review the material covered in class.

Math–2nd grade will be working on subtraction concepts while 3rd grade will be focusing on addition. Keep practicing the addition and subtraction facts. I have shown the kids house to use the triangular shaped flashcards.

Reading- We are reading the story <u>Super Storms</u>. We will be focusing on the main idea and supporting details.. Our corresponding grammar lessons will be focused on verbs. This week's story lends itself to great science concepts so we will be discussing the different types of storms covered in the passage.

Phonics & Spelling—The kids are doing very well with the Saxon phonics program. They will continue to have spelling words, which you can find glued into your child's assignment notebook. Please continue to review your child's spelling words with them. I have put together individualized sight word decks that the children are studying at school. Please continue to have your child read and spell the listed sight words in your child's binder.
